SciVet Summer Program & Scholarship Application

To be eligible for the SciVet Summer Program at Colorado State University, students must be entering the 10th through 12th grades in Fall 2024 AND be at least 15 years of age by June 17th. This application packet is for students who are also applying for scholarship aid to attend the program.

The Natural Sciences Education & Outreach Center will provide a few scholarships (up to the cost of program tuition and room and board - \$1,670 maximum for residential & \$1,070 maximum for commuter) to disadvantaged students. These scholarships are based on disadvantaged circumstances and the student's motivation.

<u>Parent Instructions</u>: Please complete the Financial Information form and submit a brief, typed (no more than one page) statement describing your circumstances in light of the following criteria.

Disadvantaged circumstances will be evaluated in the following categories:

- *Economic factors*: a demonstrated history of low income of applicant and family unit prior to college entrance and pre-veterinary education; level of financial support provided by applicant to the family unit prior to and during pre-veterinary education; if applicant has a major financial responsibility to a household and history of financial aid.
- *Educational factors*: inadequate early education because of frequent change of schools during elementary and secondary education; unusual number of hours of employment or necessitated other time commitments during high school for supporting self and family unit; lack of exposure to academic role models and of participation in sound educational programs.
- **Cultural/Environmental factors:** born to immigrant parents; reared in an ethnic minority culture; reared in a family with English as a second language; experienced bi-cultural stress as a result of transition from a predominantly ethnic minority community to an academic environment; reared in an economically depressed area; reared by someone other than parents; reared in an environment lacking exposure to opportunities offered by higher education; reared in an environment of abuse such as alcohol, drugs, child abuse, and other physical abuse.

Student Instructions: Please complete the Student Applicant Information Form and submit a brief, typed (no more than 500 words) statement explaining why you want to attend the SciVet Summer Program. Please address what interests you about the program and why the program would be an enrichment experience for you. Any additional information submitted (i.e.: transcripts and letters of recommendation) <u>will not</u> be considered in the review process.

Application Submission:

Scholarship application forms, along with the parent and student statements are due to the Natural Sciences Education & Outreach Center no later than February 1, 2024. Acceptance to the program along with scholarship awards will be announced on March 1, 2024. Mail to:

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Application Policy:

Submitting the SciVet Program & Scholarship Application does not guarantee a scholarship – students may be accepted into the program without receiving scholarship aid. All applications are due February 1, 2024 and decisions will be announced via email on March 1, 2023. Once accepted into the program, registrations are due to Conference Services by March 15, 2024.

Registration Policy:

A link to the online registration form will be included in the email acceptance notifications. Formal registrations include the online form, non-refundable registration fee of \$70, the Release from Responsibility, Assumption of Risk and Waiver Form, the Consent for Treatment of Unemancipated Minor Form, the Student Code of Conduct Form, the Emergency Card Form and a copy of the student's medical insurance card.

Payment Policy:

<u>Credit cards are not accepted.</u> Checks or money orders must be payable to Colorado State University. A \$25 handling fee will be charged on all returned checks. Once accepted into program and registered online, the non-refundable registration fee of \$70 is due to Conference Services by March 15, 2024 in order to hold the spot for your student. Full payments are due May 31, 2024.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy:

Students withdrawing from the program may receive tuition refunds, minus the non-refundable registration fee. The Natural Sciences Education & Outreach Center (NSEOC) must be notified at least 14 days prior to the first day of the course by calling (970) 491-7716 or emailing courtney.butler@colostate.edu. Refunds take at least 6-8 weeks to be processed. The effective withdrawal date is the day that NSEOC is officially notified of the intent to withdraw. *The NSEOC reserves the right to cancel the program up to 2 weeks before the start of the camp if minimum enrollments are not met.* Full refunds are made to the students who are enrolled at the time the course is cancelled. Non-attendance does not constitute withdrawal.
