

Lepo (Soil) Station



Action	Explanation
Lā'au (Plants)	Water is drawn into native plants such as the Lehua, Koa, Noni, etc.
'Ā pele (Lava)	Water soaks through soil into cracks in the lava.
Ao (Clouds)	Water evaporates into the atmosphere.
Lepo (Soil)	Soil is covered with broad leaves to prevent evaporation.

'Ā pele (Lava) Station



Action	Explanation
Ālialia nono (Anchialine Pools)	Water flows through cracks and tubes into anchialine pools.
Holoholona a me Po'e (Animals & People)	Water is pumped out of the ground and used for houses, swimming pools, golf courses, etc.
Moana (Ocean)	Cold, fresh water comes out into the ocean through springs that create wavy haloclines near the reefs.

Lā'au (Plants) Station



Action	Explanation
Ao (Clouds)	Water comes out of the plant leaves and evaporates into the atmosphere.
Lā'au (Plants)	Plants use the water to grow.

Ao (Clouds) Station



Action	Explanation
Wao Kele (Cloud Forest)	Clouds condense onto the leaves of Koa and Lehua trees.
'Ā pele (Lava)	Clouds precipitate rain and it falls and soaks into cracks of lava.
Lepo (Soil)	Clouds precipitate rain and it falls and soaks into the soil.
Moana (Ocean)	Clouds precipitate rain and it falls into the ocean.
Ao (Clouds)	Clouds can move around with the wind, carrying water.

Wao Kele (Cloud Forest) Station



Action	Explanation
Lepo (Soil)	Tiny water droplets condense onto the leaves of trees and eventually drip onto the soil below.
Wao Kele (Cloud Forest)	Water droplets hang around the tops of the trees as fog or vog.

Ālialia nono (Anchialine Pools) Station



Action	Explanation
Ao (Clouds)	Water evaporates from the surface of the pool.
Moana (Ocean)	Anchialine pools are connected to the ocean through cracks in the lava.
Holoholona a me Po'e (Animals & People)	Animals depend on these brackish water pools to survive. The animals are connected to the culture of the people.

Moana (Ocean) Station



Action	Explanation
Ao (Clouds)	The sun warms the surface of the ocean and causes the water to evaporate.
Ālialia nono (Anchialine Pools)	Anchialine pools are connected to the ocean through cracks in the lava.

Holoholona a me Po'e (Animals & People) Station



Action	Explanation
Lepo (Soil)	Our waste water is returned to the soil.
Ao (Clouds)	A lot of the water we use for agriculture evaporates into the atmosphere.
Holoholona a me Po'e (Animals & People)	Animals and people need water to stay alive.
